You are invited to begin the New Year with concerted prayer. For the first **21 days, January 1-21**, we will pray through the Gospel of John taking one chapter a day. The prayer point following the scripture may be prayed for yourself, your nation, another nation, ASK Network or the Church worldwide.

The **last 10 days, January 22-3**, will be focused on the International Gathering of ASK leaders and intercessors in the Negev, Israel. The focus is on all that God may accomplish there. However, your covering prayers for the practical aspects of provision, health, safety, accommodation, travel and so on are greatly appreciated.

Please fast when and how the Lord leads. We pray that this month that is consecrated for prayer will be a blessing to you and effective for the Kingdom of God.

Guideline: We encourage you to read first the whole chapter assigned to that day. Select verses follow also in blue print. The words in black print are to help give focus for prayer and meditation.



JOHN 1

1:1 In the beginning was the Word ... the Word was God.

- Word of God would be primary to every thought and action. 1:10 He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world knew Him not.
- Jesus would be made known around the world.

1:29, 42 Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! We have found the Messiah (that is, the Christ).

Jesus would be worshiped as Lord and Saviour, the Anointed One.

May the people of God follow the example of Jesus with diligence.
Thu JAN 5	 JOHN 5 5:8 Then Jesus said to him, "Get up! Pick up your mat and walk." ASK for miraculous responses from both the physically and spiritually lame. 5:27 Very truly I tell you, whoever hears My word and believes Him who sent Me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life. Hearing of the Word, would lead to belief in Jesus, freedom from guilt and condemnation. 5:27 (The Father) has given Him authority to judge because He is the Son of Man. For the followers of Jesus to understand and move in the authority of Jesus.
Fri JAN 6	 JOHN 6 6:2 A great crowd of people followed Him because they saw the signs He had performed by healing the sick. The compassion of Jesus would be manifest in healing as a sign for "a great crowd." 6:27 Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. Diligent work. Godly priorities. Sharing the gospel. 6:44 No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws them, and I will raise them up at the last day. ASK the Father to draw those from every tribe, tongue, people, nation.
Sat JAN 7	 JOHN 7 7: 16 Jesus answered, "My teaching is not my own. It comes from the One who sent Me. " Teaching would come from time spent listening to the Lord. 7:18 Whoever speaks on their own does so to gain personal glory, but he who seeks the glory of the One who sent Him is a man of truth; there is nothing false about him. ASK for a wholehearted, uncompromising commitment to the Glory of God. 7:38 Whoever believes in Me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them. Pray for rivers of living water to flow through believers.
